



What we do:

MCTAC Plus (+) is a group of partners from [New York Association Psychiatric Rehabilitation Services \(NYAPRS\)](#), [The Coalition for Behavioral Health](#), [The Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Providers of New York State \(ASAP\)](#) and [Families Together in New York State \(FTNYS\)](#) that come together through MCTAC to provide individualized and hands-on training and technical assistance to behavioral health providers throughout NYS on the successful transition to Managed Care Medicaid. This includes topics such as HCBS implementation, the transition to Value Based Payments, and the children's system transformation just to name a few.

Who we serve:

- Providers who want more individualized or intensive training experience
- Providers who want assistance operationalizing these learned concepts
- Providers who want information from MCTAC to be broken down and explained further
- Community providers who have no or little previous experience billing Medicaid

Services:

- Regional forums on topics related to Medicaid Managed Care transition, infrastructure development and HCBS implementation
- Webinars, videos, on line learning opportunities, learning communities related to the transition to Medicaid Managed Care
- Monthly newsletters with information on MCTAC resources and updates on our evolving health care system
- **Individual consultation** with providers, their administrative and direct care staff
- Regional workshops and trainings on topics relevant to the transition to Medicaid Managed Care and the implementation of HCBS
- Short videos that help providers keep up with changes in our health care system





Our approach:

- **Smaller, more intimate** events, such as web based events and in person trainings that give providers the opportunity to ask questions specific to their organization's transition to Managed Care
- Workshops and webinars **tailored to the specific needs** of providers who have less experience billing Medicaid
- Assisting providers with successfully **overcoming the challenges** associated with the transition to Managed Care
