



Post-Event Summary: What You Need to Know

Event Title: Children and Family Treatment and Support Services In-Person Training

Date and Location: May 30th Rochester, May 31st Binghamton, June 1st Tarrytown, June 5th NYC, June 8th Albany

Audience: Providers serving individuals under 21, who are designated to provide or plan to provide Children and Family Treatment and Support Services (State Plan Services).

Event Summary: These full day in-person trainings reviewed the Children's System Implementation Timeline and four of the new children's services: Other Licensed Practitioner (OLP), Community Psychiatric Supports and Treatment (CPST), Psychosocial Rehabilitation (PSR), and Family Peer Support Services (FPSS).

Key Takeaways:

- 1) Summarizes key changes to Children's Medicaid Redesign timeline
- 2) Reviews goals for Children's Design including expansion of services for youth from birth to 21
- 3) Details service components and provider qualifications for Other Licensed Practitioner, Community Psychiatric Supports and treatment, Psychosocial Rehabilitation, and Family Peer Support Services
- 4) Reviews Medical Necessity
- 5) Identifies how the services can be utilized as part of a comprehensive service array

Recommended Next Steps:

- Review updated Children and Family Treatment and Support Services provider manual upon release (**anticipated 6/2018**)
- Review Children and Family Treatment and Support Services billing manual (**anticipated 6/2018**)
- Engage in outreach with potential referral sources and Managed Care Plans
