

Scenarios for VFCAs with Only CSE Youth in their Care

Scenario A:

CSE only Program

Services:

5 Core Services Only= Residual Per Diem
(Residual = Medicaid rate)

What's Needed:

1. 29-I application
2. Medical Necessity
3. Comprehensive Individual Treatment Plan
4. Staff Ratios
5. Core Residual Services

Billing:

MSAR + Residual Rate = "CSE proxy rate" which is billed to the school district & LDSS (as it is today)

*Scenario A does not require *contracting with MCOs or Claims Testing*

Scenario B:

CSE only Program

Services:

5 Core Services (Residual) & Other 29-I Services CFTSS/Other Limited Health Related Services (i.e. physician, psychiatric, etc.)

What's Needed:

- 1-5 above
6. Determine child's insurance status (Medicaid/Third-Party Health Insurance)
7. MCO Contracting or TPHI Contracting
8. Rate Negotiating (Other Limited Health Related Services-i.e. physician, psychiatric, etc.)
9. Claims Testing

Billing:

5 Core Services

MSAR + Residual Rate = "CSE proxy rate" which is billed to the school district & LDSS (as it is today)

CFTSS/Other Limited Health Related Services (i.e. physicians, psychiatrists, etc.)

- If Child has Medicaid, is enrolled in a Managed Care plan, agency has contract, agency bills MCO
- If Child has Medicaid, is not yet enrolled in a Managed Care plan, agency bills eMedNY (Fee For Service)
- If Child has TPHI, agency has contract, agency bills TPHI

Scenarios for VFCAs with Both Foster Care & CSE Youth in their Care

Scenario C: Foster Care & CSE Program
Services: 5 Core Services (Residual) Only

What's Needed:

1. 29-I application
2. Medical Necessity
3. Comprehensive Individual Treatment Plan
4. Staff Ratios
5. Core Residual Services

Billing:

5 Core Services

- Foster Care Youth:
 - If Child has Medicaid, is enrolled in a Managed Care plan, agency has contract, agency bills MCO
 - If a Child has Medicaid, is not yet enrolled in a Managed Care plan, agency bills eMedNY (Fee For Service)
- CSE Youth: MSAR + Residual Rate = "CSE proxy rate" which is billed to the school district & LDSS (as it is today)

Scenario D: Foster Care & CSE Program
Services: 5 Core Services (Residual) & Other 29-I Services CFTSS/HCBS/Other Limited Health Related Services (i.e. physician, psychiatric, etc.)

What's Needed:

1-5 above

6. Determine child's insurance status (Medicaid or TPHI)
7. MCO Contracting or TPHI Contracting
8. Rate Negotiating (Other Limited Health Related Services-i.e. physician, psychiatric, etc.)
9. Claims Testing

Billing:

5 Core Services

- Foster Care Youth:
